On November 9, our country celebrates the Day of Ukrainian Writing and Language. This holiday was started by the Decree of the President of Ukraine on November 6, 1997. Traditionally, on this day, all Ukrainians are invited to write the All-Ukrainian dictation of national unity and test their knowledge.

According to the Orthodox calendar, November

9 commemorates the Venerable Nestor the Chronicler - a follower of Kyryl and Methodius. It is believed that Nestor Litopyssets became the progenitor of the Ukrainian written language.

In 1989, the Verkhovna Rada granted the status of the state language to the Ukrainian language. It is also the native language of Ukrainians living outside of Ukraine. Almost 45 million people speak Ukrainian and it is one of the most widely spoken languages in the world. Genealogically, the Ukrainian language belongs to the Indo-European language family. This is evidenced by archaisms and some phonetic and morphological features that our language has preserved over the centuries.

Cossack state documents and chronicles were written in the ancient Ukrainian language, original artistic writing of the eras was created - from Ivan Vyshensky to Hryhoriy Skovoroda. Ukrainians have their powerful classical literature, world-recognized geniuses: Taras Shevchenko, Ivan Franko, Lesya Ukrainka, Mykhailo Kotsiubynskyi, Vasyl Stefanyk...

Regarding the beginning of writing in Ukrainian lands, scientific discussions continue. Archaeological finds testify to the presence of written signs on pottery, spinning wheels, weapons, etc., as early as the Trypilian era.

On this day, it has already become a tradition, the International Competition of Experts of the Ukrainian Language named after Petro Yatsyk starts. The annual number of participants of the competition is more than 5 million from many countries of the world.

Travel around Ukraine

At the time of quarantine many countries have closed their borders so Ukrainians should think about the prospect of travelling in Ukraine.

Ukraine has got many historical and cultural monuments, nature reserves. Let's look at some interesting destinations.



1. Biosphere Reserve “Askania-Nova” The reserve is located in the Kherson region. There are at least 1155 species of arthropods, 7 species of amphibians and reptiles, 18 species of mammals, at different times of the year more than 270 species of birds. In addition 478 species of plants grow here.

In 1874 the reserve was founded in Askania by Friedrich Falz-Fein. The

purpose of the zoo was the progressive idea to learn, to reproduce rare species of animals in semi-free conditions, so that later they could restore them in nature in the event of extinction of the latter. He was also one of the first in the region to start ringing birds during migration. In 1887 a botanical garden was established.

2. Kamianets-Podilskyi

The city of Magdeburg law, one of the main centers of the historical region of Podilya. The royal city of the Commonwealth, historically the main administrative-territorial unit of Western Podilya, from March 22, 1919 to November 1920- the capital of the UPR, former regional center(1921-1953), modern significant economic, educational, cultural and tourist center of the country. It's a member of the Association of Ukrainian Cities. It has its own coat of arms and flag.



3. Vorokhta

Vorokhta, in the Ivano-Frankivsk region, attracts not only fans of eco-recreation. Picturesque mountain slopes, spectacular landscapes open from this small town, which is located at an altitude of 850 m above sea level.

Vorokhta has managed to preserve its color to this day- everything here is reminiscent of the old life. One of the interesting local attractions is the Church of the Nativity of the Virgin, built of wood. The temple boasts of its original beauty, as its exterior is not spoiled by modern decoration. The building was brought in 1780 from Yablunytsia, but the age of construction is unknown. According to legend, the church was used for its intended purpose in 1615. The chapel is interesting for its original architecture. It was destroyed under unknown circumstances and rebuilt during the Austro-Hungarian Empire but in a reduced form. The chapel was damaged again in 1940, this time due to the promotion of atheism and it wasn't until 1997 that the monument was restored.



4. Lutsk

Lutsk is one of the most ancient cities in Ukraine. It was built in 1085. Lutsk Lubart Castle is one of the oldest and best preserved castles in Ukraine. In 2011, the Upper Castle took first place in the action "7 Wonders of Ukraine".



The longest residential building in Europe is located in Lutsk. Its length is 3265 m. It contains 88 entrances which are 38 different addresses on two streets. About 9000 people live there.

Lutsk "Museum of the Volyn Icon" is the only one in Ukraine where a unique collection of regional icons is kept.

He learns that Senku also managed to shed the stone shell, counting every second of his existence. This story is full of different plot twists and science, so it will be very interesting for students, who want to broaden their mind.



The next one is a light anime, which is a genre of comedy and romance. As you might have guessed it is "**HoriMiya**", the new latest Japanese multiplication. At first glance, it may seem that main character Hori is an ordinary teenage girl, but appearances can be deceiving. Latin pop music & Zumba

45 years ago in 1975, UNESCO established international Music Day- a holiday that unites the hearts of all people who write, play, sing or simply can't imagine a day of their lives without music. Every year Music Day is celebrated by holding concerts with the participation of the best artistic groups, musicians and artists. Invaluable works and masterpieces that have become the property of world music culture and heard all over the world. The music festival concerns almost everyone. After all, everyone understands the language of music- regardless of nationality, age or social status. In music person finds inspiration and strength that opens and purifies his soul. One of the most popular kind of music is Latin pop. Latin musicians have a lot of fans around the world. Their tracks win awards and become hits.

Zumba combines simple elements of such dances as salsa, bachata, rumba, cha-cha-cha, samba, flamenco, belly dance, hip-hop –and that's not the limit. Also we can't ignore the founder of the direction of Zumba, choreographer- dancer from Colombia Alberto Perez. Interestingly, the practice was

completely accidental, when the choreographer simply forgot to train his playlist on the disc and he had to practice under Latin American rhythms. The training turned out to be so inflammatory and energetic that the dancer was inspired to develop this program. As a result, we have formed the direction of Zumba, which is practiced in many fitness clubs around the world.

I decided to interview a coach of Zumba Alina Khymko(21 y.o.)

- What do you like about Latin music?
- Latin American music is something unique, their rhythms from the first tones awaken in you energy and desire to dance. While still at university, I became interested in Latin music. I wanted to learn Zumba and improve in this direction.
- How long did you study it?
- First, I started going to a fitness club that had a Zumba fitness program. It took place in the city where I studied. I practiced there for almost a year. After that I returned to Chervonohrad and for almost a year now, since the first day of opening fitness program, I have been actively involved in my city.
- How much time do you spend on training?
- I train at least 4 times a week.
- What is your program of training?
- My workouts are accompanied by music, rhythmic movements and involve absolutely all the muscles of the body. As a result, people who practice Zumba not only acquire a beautiful figure, good health, good mood, but can impress everyone with beautiful dance technique.
- Which Latin American artists are your favorites?
